## BROKEN: A MESSAGE OF HOPE

*A bruised reed he will not break, and a smouldering wick he will not snuff out. Isaiah 42:3*

We live in a broken world. Brokenness is all around us.

In what ways might you feel broken?

In Luke 7:36-50 we meet a daring woman holding an alabaster jar, who, in the face of condemnation receives her forgiveness, peace and acceptance in the presence of her loving saviour—Jesus.

*Kintsugi* is the Japanese art of repairing broken pottery by mending the areas of breakage with lacquer dusted or mixed with powdered gold, silver, or platinum. As a philosophy, it treats breakage and repair as part of the history of an object, rather than something to disguise.

In that same way Jesus ministers to the shattered pieces of our brokenness to produce a unique and beautiful mosaic.
