- 1 Psalm 150:6**
Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord!
- 2 Philippians 4:19**
And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.
- 3 Exodus 31:6b**
I have given ability to all the skilled workers to do everything I have commanded you.
- 4 Proverbs 4:11**
I instruct you in the way of wisdom and lead you along straight paths.
- 5 Isaiah 41:10**
Fear not, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my victorious right hand.
- 6 Luke 10:2**
He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."
- 7 Psalm 19:14**
May these words of my mouth and this meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.
- 8 Proverbs 2:6-7**
For the Lord gives wisdom, from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. He holds success in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless.
- 9 Colossians 3:17**
And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
- 10 Colossians 3:23-24**
Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.
- 11 Psalm 86:11**
Teach me your way, Lord, that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.
- 12 Acts 11:23**
When he arrived and saw what the grace of God had done, he was glad and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with all their hearts.
- 13 2 Corinthians 1:12**
Now this is our boast: our conscience testifies that we have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially in our relations with you, with integrity and godly sincerity. We have done so, relying not on worldly wisdom but on God's grace.
- 14 Psalm 121: 7-8**
The Lord will keep you from all harm- He will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.
- 15 Romans 12:5**
In Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.
- 16 1 Corinthians 3:7**
So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters are anything, but only God who gives the growth.
- 17 Ephesians 4:11-12**
And he himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, to build up the body of Christ.
- 18 Matthew 25:23**
His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You were faithful over a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Share your master's joy'.
- 19 Philippians 4:6**
Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
- 20 1 Corinthians 15:58**
Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labour in the Lord is not in vain.
- 21 Mark 4: 30b-32**
What shall we say the kingdom of God is like, or what parable shall we use to describe it? It is like a mustard seed, which is the smallest of all seeds on earth. Yet when planted, it grows and becomes the largest of all garden plants, with such big branches that the birds can perch in its shade.
- 22 John 10:4**
When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice.
- 23 Philippians 1:6**
I am sure of this, that he who started a good work in you will carry it on to the completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
- 24 2 Corinthians 9:11-12**
You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God. This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of the Lord's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God.
- 25 Ecclesiastes 3:1**
There is a time for everything, and a season for all things under the heavens.
- 26 1 Peter 4:10**
